So, you were chosen as maid of honor for an upcoming wedding. Congrats! Here's a list of responsibilities leading up to the big day:

PRE-WEDDING


- Lend a helping hand and ear to the bride
- Possibly help **search for vendors**, address envelopes, choose cake flavors or yes, even provide feedback on china patterns for the registry
- Be a point person - be aware of all the wedding details and registry information in case other guests have questions
- Plan a bachelorette party 
- Attend wedding dress shopping and fittings 
- **Lead the bridal party!** Make sure they:
 - Purchase their dresses and accessories
 - Confirm hair and makeup appointments
 - Help coordinate travel accommodations 
- Host or co-host a bridal shower
- Attend all pre-wedding events, including the engagement party, rehearsal, and rehearsal dinner





THE BIG DAY!

CEREMONY

MAKE SURE YOU'RE WELL-VERSED IN THE WEDDING TIMELINE AND DETAILS!

- Get prepped and dressed with the bride and other bridal party members
- Have all vendor's contact information nearby
- Arrange the bride's train and veil upon her arrival to the altar
- Hold the bride's bouquet during the exchange of vows
- Prepare an emergency kit for the bride 
- Keep the bride calm, cool, and collected
- Hold the groom's ring
- Sign the marriage license as a witness along with the best man

RECEPTION

- Stand next to the groom in the receiving line (optional)
- Help bustle the bride's train and remove veil before dancing, this includes going to the restroom too!
- Dance with the best man during the first formal dance (you can dance with whoever you want thereafter!) 
- **Make sure the bride eats and drinks!**
- Be announced with the best man upon entering the reception
- **PLAY HOST -- DIRECT GUESTS TO THE GUESTBOOK AND WHERE TO DROP OFF GIFTS AND WHERE TO SIT.**
- Give a toast to the newlyweds after the best man 
- Help out with any last details at the end of the night - including making sure gifts are safely transported

POST-WEDDING

- Make sure all of the wedding gifts are safely collected and transported to their final destination
- Take a day off & Pat yourself on the back
